






















Painting depicting 'Pentecost' from the Drogo Sacramentary (France, c.850 CE)










Ivory panel depicting Emperor Otto I with Christ, Saint Peter, and angels (Germany, c.965 CE)




Bronze doors of Bishop Bernward (Monastery of Saint Michael, Hildesheim, Germany, 1015 CE)
