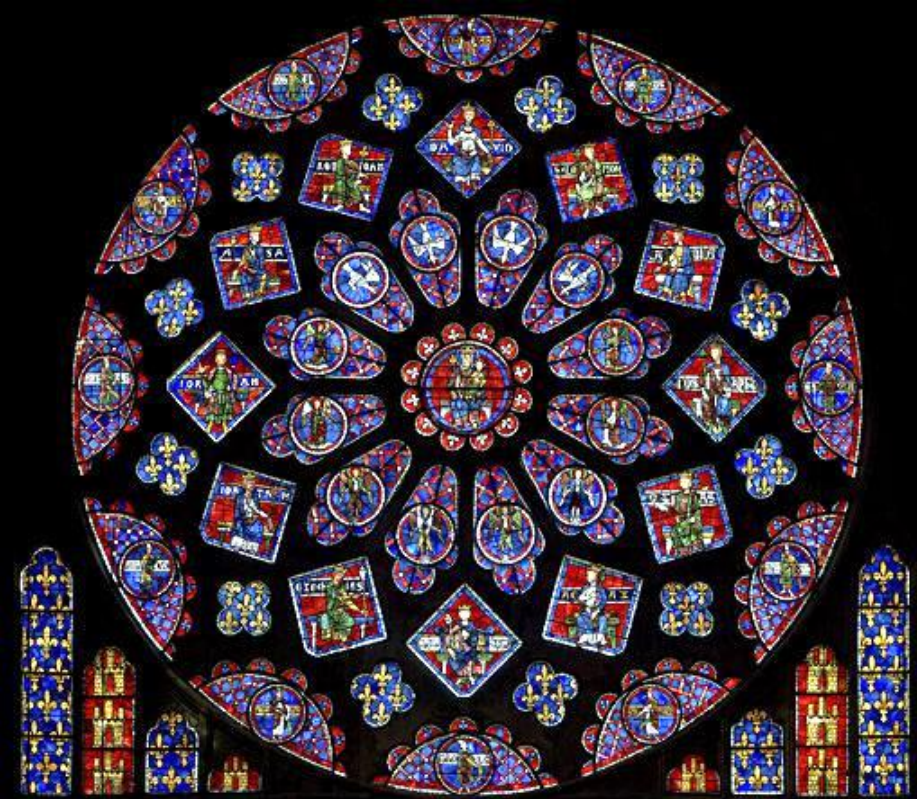

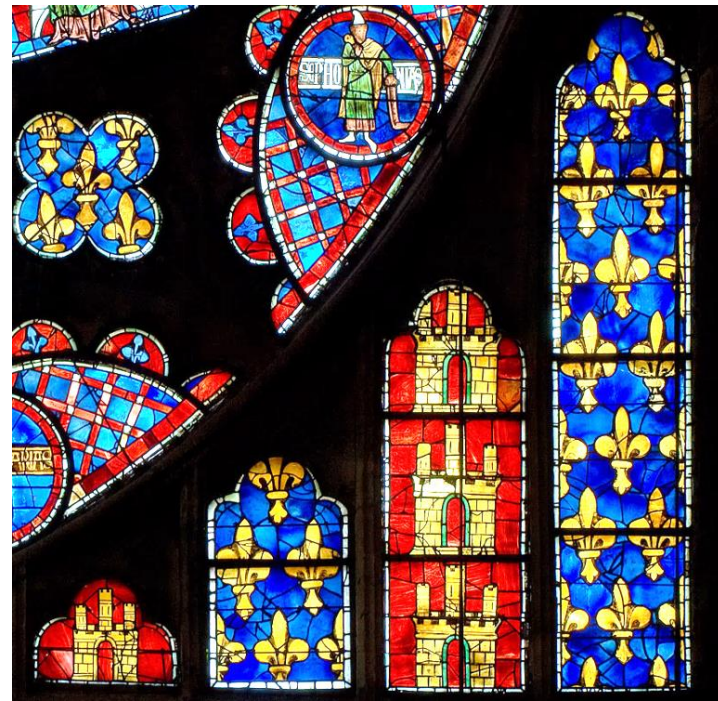
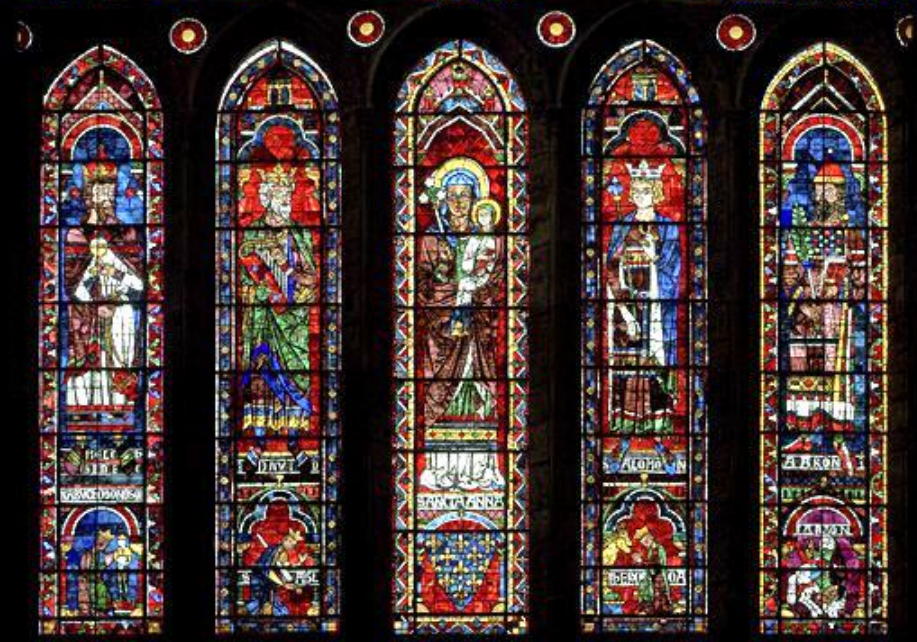


Detail of the figures within the archivolts and full view of the sculpture over the right doorway of the 'Royal Portal' at Chartres Cathedral (c.1150)

Manuscript painting depicting God creating the Universe, from a 'Moralized Bible' created for Louis IX (c.1230)



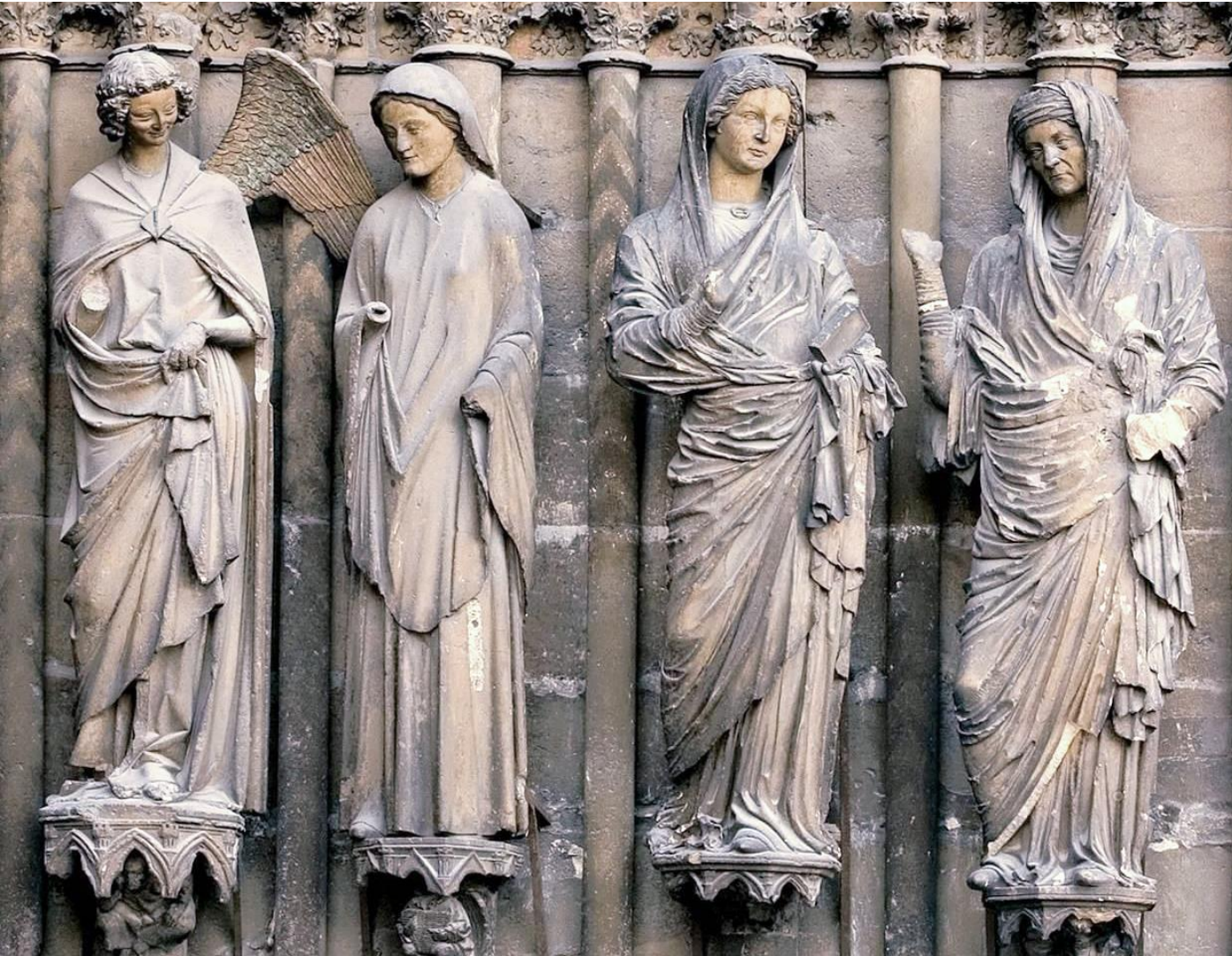

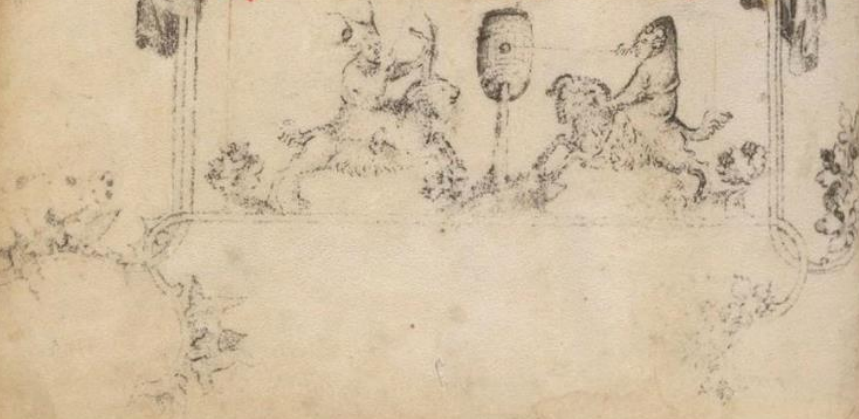
