






Father Carlo Buonaparte






Napoleon







Jean Ingres, Napoleon as First Consul


Concordat of 1801

- Reconciliation between Catholic Church and the Rev.
- Catholicism the "majority" religion but gave religious freedom
- Did not restore Church lands
- Nap. Thus remained in control so the Pope rejected it, Nap. Arrests him




Priests signing agreement to the Concordat ju

Ingres, Napoleon on his Imperial Throne, Paris, 1806




Treaty of Tilsit, 1807
